Many people enjoy the modern convenience, safety and reliability of making automatic deposits or transactions through the automated banking system. Now you can make stewardship contributions through the Sacred Heart Cathedral Automated Offering Plan. Simply complete the attached form, enclose it along with a check marked void put it in an envelope marked Automated Offering and place it in the collection basket and we'll do the rest. It's safe, easy and absolutely free.

This plan is similar to payment programs offered by banks and utility companies. Your contributions are automatically withdrawn from a regular checking account at any bank or credit union. No one but you has access to your account and nothing can be withdrawn without your authorization. And you can change or cancel your contributions by simply sending a written notice to the parish office.

This plan was developed at the request of parishioners and is not expected to be attractive to everyone. Some of their comments heard which prompted the establishment of the program include: "I always forget my envelope." "My wife and I attend different masses and we are never sure if the other put the offering in." "We travel a lot and this would make it easier to be regular contributors." "I do all my banking electronically or by credit card, I don't use checks or cash." "I can't think of a better way to insure that I am giving from the first fruits and not the leftovers."
